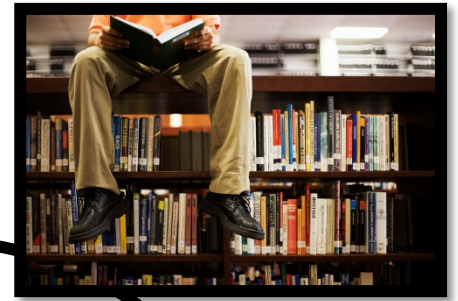

- Subtitles



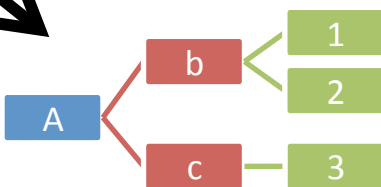
## Step TWO: Read

## Step THREE: Outline

Make a chart (flow chart, Hierarchy chart, basic outline) of the chapter in your notebook. This will help you to review what you just read.

Try to find the answers to your post-its. If you cannot find the answer write the question down in your notes and be sure to ask in class!
